Dwyka Diamonds Limited ('Dwyka' or the 'Company')

Concrete delivery commences at the Kimberley prison site

On 14 February 2007, the Company announced that through its South African based BEE compliant subsidiary it had been awarded a contract for the supply of concrete to a new prison facility to be established near Kimberley, South Africa.

Further to this announcement, Dwyka is pleased to announce that concrete delivery commenced on Monday 26 February. Over the next two weeks, 100 cubic metres of concrete will be supplied from the Company's Kimberley batching plant. Beyond the initial deliveries, concrete will be supplied from an on-site batching plant. 500 cubic metres will be required in March, increasing to a target of 2,000 cubic metres per month over a supply duration of 17 months. In total, over 40,000 cubic metres will be delivered at an average price of about ZAR 600 per cubic metre generating total expected revenues of approximately ZAR 24,000,000 as previously advised.
