The Company has today issued and allotted a further 2,772,466 ordinary fully paid Nyota shares (the 'Shares') as consideration.

Application has been made to the AIM Market of the London Stock Exchange ('AIM') for the Shares to be admitted to trading on AIM ('Admission'). Admission is expected to take place at 8.00a.m. on 28 October 2009.

The Company gives this notice pursuant to Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act.

The Shares were issued without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act, in reliance on Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act.
